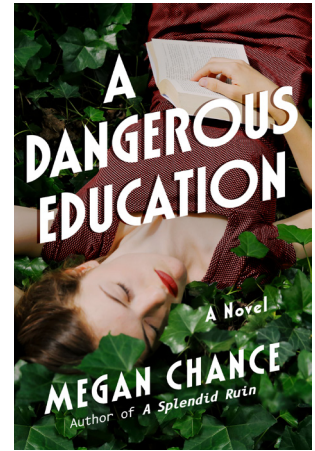


A Dangerous Education
